



INSTRUCTIONS FOR E-POSTER PRESENTATIONS

- All the e-poster presentations should be recorded in short videos (maximum 5 minutes) in .mp4 format or equivalent. These videos will be available in YouTube previously to the conference and the best selected presentations will be showed during the webconference.
- We recommend to emphasize the key scientific questions (hypothesis) and the main results in your video. Be aware that the audience needs clear information in short time to understand what you are proposing (your main hypothesis) and how you are trying to solve this (your findings).
- References (previously published papers, other conference materials, etc.) should follow in the last page of your presentation. Please use the e-poster template (available for download [here](#)).
